**A BILL**

To exempt goods imported by or for the use of small business concerns from the duties imposed by the national emergency declared on February 1, 2025 by the President.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 The Act may be cited as the “Creating Access to Nec-  
5 essary American-Canadian Duty Adjustments Act” or the  
6 “CANADA Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN GOODS FROM NATIONAL**  
2 **EMERGENCY.**

3 Duties imposed by the national emergency declared  
4 on February 1, 2025 by the President in Executive Order  
5 14193 (90 Fed. Reg. 9113), as amended by Executive  
6 Order 14197 (90 Fed. Reg. 9183) and Executive Order  
7 14226 (90 Fed. Reg. 11369), shall not apply with respect  
8 to goods imported by or for the use of small business con-  
9 cerns, as defined in section 3 of the Small Business Act  
10 (15 U.S.C. 632).
