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**A BILL**

To ban the use of intentionally added perfluoroalkyl or  
polyfluoroalkyl substances in cosmetics.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “No PFAS in Cosmetics  
5       Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. BAN ON PERFLUOROALKYL OR POLYFLUOROALKYL**  
7       **SUBSTANCES.**

8       (a) DIRECTED RULEMAKING.—Not later than 270  
9       days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
10      of Health and Human Services (referred to in this section

1 as the “Secretary”) shall issue a proposed rule to ban the  
2 use of intentionally added perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl  
3 substances in cosmetics. Not later than 90 days after  
4 issuing the proposed rule, the Secretary shall finalize such  
5 rule.

6 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term  
7 “perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance” means a  
8 perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance that is man-  
9 made and has at least 1 fully-fluorinated carbon atom.
