RESOLUTION

Recognizing November 2025 as “National Family Caregivers
Month”.

Whereas, in 2025, there were 63,000,000 family caregivers in
the United States who provide essential care to millions
of people each year, providing unpaid care worth an esti-
mated \$600,000,000,000 annually;

Whereas family caregivers play a vital role in the healthcare
system of the United States, supporting loved ones who
have chronic illnesses, disabilities, and are aging;

Whereas family caregivers, who are disproportionately
women, often face significant challenges including finan-
cial strain, physical and emotional exhaustion, and social
isolation; and

Whereas “National Family Caregivers Month” is an oppor-
tunity to recognize and appreciate the contributions of

family caregivers of all ages and to advocate for policies that support family caregivers: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) recognizes November 2025 as “National
3 Family Caregivers Month”;

4 (2) commends the 63,000,000 family caregivers
5 in the United States who provide essential care to
6 their loved ones and chosen family each day;

7 (3) recognizes the importance of the 2022 Na-
8 tional Strategy to Support Family Caregivers as a
9 roadmap to better support caregivers in the United
10 States; and

11 (4) encourages all people of the United States
12 to learn more about family caregiving and to support
13 their loved ones and neighbors who are providing
14 care.
